STUDENT DIRECTIONS

Students are encouraged to work in groups of 2 or independently. Groups can assist each other to develop their own Digital Career map.

1. Review the Career zone assessments and Job Zones/ clusters in their digital portfolio.
2. Create a career collage, a personal career map using your choice of digital software/technology (Publisher, Canva) or use a basic Microsoft program. The Career collage should represent your chosen career.
3. Digital Career Map should include at least 5 of the following:
 - A video link embedded into the poster
 - Visual pictures of someone doing tasks within the career
 - Include the vocabulary of the career
 - The progression of the occupation/career choice
 - A description of credentials, certifications, and/or specialized training required
 - Prerequisites required from high school
 - A short list of activities that a person in that occupation would be doing on a daily basis. A list of qualities and skills needed for the job
 - Where the career is found in the world
 - Job outlook and average salary
